Dear Friends of the Nisqually Land Trust:

Welcome to our annual Conservation Celebration & Auction. Tonight, we celebrate two milestones in the history of your Nisqually Land Trust:

- The 50th anniversary of the historic Boldt Decision, which affirmed not only that Native Americans had treaty rights to half the salmon catch in the state but even more importantly that Native Tribes are sovereign nations; and
- The 35th anniversary of the Land Trust, which grew directly out of the Boldt Decision and the Nisqually Tribe's launch of the Nisqually Watershed salmon recovery program.

We are greatly honored to have two speakers tonight who are descended from this historic lineage and have themselves been at the forefront of Nisqually conservation:

- Willie Frank III, former chair of the Nisqually Tribal Council. Willie's grand father, Willie Frank Sr., won the first legal battles for native fishing rights, in the 1930s, and his father, Billy Frank Jr., was arrested over fifty times on the trail to the Boldt Decision.
- Rep. J. T. Wilcox, a founding member of the Land Trust board. The conversion of J.T.'s father, Jim Wilcox, from foe to friend of Billy Frank Jr. is a foundational story in the Watershed's evolution from Ground Zero of the brutal Fish Wars to an internationally recognized beacon of cooperative conservation today.

Yet in many ways, our work is just beginning. Our Chinook salmon and steelhead trout, both listed under the Endangered Species Act, still hover at the edge of viability. They are still with us today in no small part thanks to the tremendous work we've all done to protect and restore their habitat.

And when we protect land for salmon we also protect it for northern spotted owls, marbled murrelets, and many other imperiled Nisqually species, and for the many people and communities who depend on a healthy Nisqually Watershed.

Your support tonight is the foundation for everything we do. It's the most flexible and powerful funding we have, leveraging a hundred times its value every year. Thank you.

And thank you, too, for being part of a great 35 years. Here's to the next 35!

This beautiful, limited edition print speaks to the mission of the Land Trust. In the artist's words: "This is a contemporary design of a Haida Salmon. The Salmon's cycle is a circular one, the river marking the beginning, the birthplace. It is from the river that the Salmon goes, and it is to the river the Salmon returns, thus coming full circle, completing the life cycle."

Artist Lyle R. Campbell is of the Sta-Sta-aas, Songalth Tribe of the Kaighani Haida of Haida Gwaii (Queen Charlotte Islands). He is a member of the Eagle Clan of the Edenshaw (It-in-su) family, and his great grandfather was Chief Albert Edward Edenshaw. Lyle's bright colors and free-flowing style have a contemporary perspective but remain true to the traditional Northwest Coast formline.

7 Custom-made Outdoor Table

Sit at this table and feel the rich history of Pacific Northwest forests. A world where giant trees, like huge classic columns, supported a green canopy two hundred feet above the ground, extending far beyond what an eagle could see. This tree was already two hundred years old when the first European settlers arrived in the Pacific Northwest, in a time where these forests thrived.

Salvaged from a 1931 Boston Harbor summer cabin, these boards are from a Douglas fir that was likely over eight feet in diameter and 250 feet tall when logged from the hills of south Puget Sound and then milled in Olympia. Hand-made by dedicated supporter and craftsman Eric Hurlburt, the table measures 6.5 feet in length.

1 3 Coast Salish Pattern Wool Blanket

Featured on the cover of Vogue in 2023 with actors Lily Gladstone (Blackfeet) and Leonardo DiCaprio for their Oscar-nominated movie Killers of the Flower Moon.

This design was created by Louie Gong (Nooksack), the founder of Eighth Generation. He often refers to the pattern as a "collaboration with the ancestors," as it was created through his research of traditional Coast Salish weaving. Coast Salish art is rarely represented in contemporary textiles, and Louie is proud to help bring this often overlooked form to the forefront of Native art.

Eighth Generation is a Seattle-based company owned by the Snoqualmie Tribe. They partner with Native artists around the country to design, manufacture, and market beautiful wool blankets and gifts. They are pioneers in the market for products featuring Native art and the stories they carry.


