The Nisqually River watershed is unique!

This beloved river is fed by five glaciers on Mount Rainier. It is the only river in the United States with its headwaters in a national park and its delta in a national wildlife refuge. The river is home to many species, including threatened species such as Chinook Salmon, steelhead trout, northern spotted owls, and marbled murrelets.

The Land Trust and its Watershed Partners have permanently protected 78 percent of the mainstem Nisqually River's 84 shoreline miles accessible to salmonids. Taking care of our protected lands requires substantial financial commitment when you're talking about forever. Forever.


GIFTS OF RETIREMENT ASSETS

GIFTS FOR THE FUTURE...

CHARITABLE LEAD TRUST

You transfer your cash or property to a trust that makes payments to us for a number of years and then passes the trust to your family without additional tax.

CHARITABLE GIFT REMAINDER TRUST

You transfer your cash or property to fund a charitable trust, which makes payments for your lifetime or a number of years and then passes the remainder to the Land Trust.

CHARITABLE GIFT ANNUITY (CGA)

Charitable Gift Annuities provide a way to make meaningful gifts while enjoying income and tax benefits now. Under the terms of a gift annuity, you make a charitable gift of cash or appreciated stock and receive dependable payments for life. The rate of payments is determined by age and number of annuitants (one or two). Nisqually Land Trust does not issue these annuities, however, we have relationships with organizations such as the Greater Tacoma Community Foundation that provide this gifting option.
